A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to add a section to outline the Annual Commission Member Participation Requirement that includes participating in one PRG program or service and volunteering at one PRG special event or program, seconded by Commissioner McDowell. VOTE: 9 YES, 1 NO. Motion Passed.
