#### **REQUEST**

Approve a resolution approving an agreement between the City and Mile High Flood District to fund a project prioritization study and create a prioritization plan for future drainage projects.

#### BACKGROUND

This agreement enables the Mile High Flood District to administer a comprehensive study of the City's storm drainage system. The purpose of the study is to evaluate the system's current performance and identify potential improvements by analyzing their costs and benefits.

The study will provide recommendations on which projects would deliver the greatest positive impact and help determine where future investments should be focused. It will also establish a strategic framework for addressing drainage needs citywide, aligning these priorities with the City's broader Capital Investment Program.

Ultimately, this effort will allow the City to:

- Develop a prioritized list of storm drainage projects,
- · Estimate funding requirements, and
- Pursue external funding opportunities to support construction of critical infrastructure.

The cost of the study is being shared between the City and the Mile High Flood District. In order for the District to use 2025 funds to participate in this study, the agreement must be adopted before the end of the 2025 fiscal and calendar year.
