

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LICENSE AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT TO ADAMS COUNTY FOR THE COLORADO LOCAL CLEAN ENTITY AIR NETWORK SENSORS TO BE LOCATED ON CITY PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) desires to participate in the Love My Air (LMA) program;

WHEREAS, Adams County (ADCO) has offered to place and maintain Colorado Local Entity Air Network (CLEAN) sensors at the Anythink Library and Bison Ridge Recreation Center;

WHEREAS, multiple municipalities across the state participate in LMA and it is an important program for understanding the impact of particulate matter on air quality;

WHEREAS, the IGA is for twenty-nine thousand three hundred seventy-six dollars and no cents (\$29,376.00), over a five year period, for the cost of maintaining the sensors and the data entry for the program; and

WHEREAS, both the City and ADCO wish to work together on their shared goal of better air quality for residents.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of License. The City Council hereby approves the license and IGA as attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the terms and conditions therein.

SECTION 2. Grant of License. A license for the placement of air monitoring sensors on City property. All rights and interests shall be defined exclusively by the terms and conditions set forth in the written license.

SECTION 3. Authorization to Execute. In accordance with Section 4.14 of the Charter of the City of Commerce City the Mayor shall execute any required document transferring interest in City owned property upon a resolution passed by a majority vote of the City’s Council.
