BACKGROUND/REQUEST

Motion to direct the City Manager and City Attorney to prepare an ordinance modifying the Council-appointees' role on the CCHA to non-voting.

The purpose behind this modification is to address the legal/ethical issues that arise as a voting member of both the CCHA and City Council.

Motion: I move to direct the City Manager and City Attorney to prepare an ordinance modifying the terms for regular (non council-appointees) CCHA commissioners from 3-year terms to 5-year terms, with no more than two consecutive terms. After serving two consecutive terms, a 1-year waiting period to reapply.

The purpose behind this modification is to be consistent with industry standards (4-5 year terms, two consecutive), CCHA's bylaws, and to enhance continuity. Longer terms will provide greater stability and consistency throughout projects, and allow commissioners additional time to develop a comprehensive understanding of housing programs, funding mechanisms, and community needs.
