## ORDINANCE NO. 2730

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-3007 OF THE COMMERCE CITY REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE TO MODIFY THE QUORUM REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SENIOR COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Commerce City established the Senior Commission to advise City Council on matters related to the older adult and senior community, to foster greater understanding of senior citizens, to encourage greater senior citizen participation in community issues, to inform the community of available services, programs, and resources, and to advocate for issues of importance to older adults; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate to modify the quorum requirements for the Senior Commission to ensure Senior Commission business is conducted in an effective and time manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

**SECTION 2. Amendment.** Section 2-3007 of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, which the changes are reflected in a clean version set forth in Exhibit B.

**SECTION 3. Repealer.** All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date**. This ordinance shall be effective pursuant to Section 5.3 of the Charter.
