REQUEST

Adopt a resolution designating posting locations for ordinances and public notices as required under Colorado Revised Statutes and the Commerce City Charter.

BACKGROUND

In order to comply with the Colorado Open Meetings Law, it is necessary for the City of Commerce City to post a listing of public meetings. Further, the posting locations of such meetings are to be designated annually and the Commerce City Charter requires council designate two public places for the posting of ordinances.

Citation	Commerce City Charter Sec. 5.6 – "With the exception of emergency ordinances and codes adopted by reference, the full text of each ordinance, including ordinances adopting codes by reference, shall, after passage on first reading and before second reading and final passage, be posted in two (2) public places in the city as such places are designated by the council."			
	Colorado Revised Statutes Sec. 24-6-402(2)(c)(I) – "In addition to any other means of full and timely notice, a local public body shall be deemed to have given full and timely notice if the notice of the meeting is posted

in a designated public place within the boundaries of the local public body no less than twenty-four hours prior to the holding of the meeting. The public place or places for posting such notice shall be designated annually at the local public body's first regular meeting of each calendar year."
