

The Energy and Carbon Management Commission (ECMC) provided notice of a Work-Over Rig on site for January 26-27th at the Edmundson 20N well. Well 20N is classified as a "drilling" and "permitted well location". This notice is for maintenance on the well.

Adams County Oil and Gas Updates

E3 received a referral for initial comments on a new oil and gas facility permit in unincorporated Adams County in December. Staff reviewed the application materials on January 23rd and provided a "no comment" response to AdCO on January 29th. The application's name is "Eagle Pad". See the adjacent map for the location.



CDPHE Air Pollution Control Division (APCD) Public Meeting Updates

APCD has a meeting on Wednesday, March 11th from 9-10:30 a.m. to learn more about the Stationary Source Control Fund, provide feedback, and ask questions. Fees are assessed and collected when stationary sources submit required emissions reports or air permit applications. The sources can be from industrial facilities, oil and gas operations, and power plants. CDPHE Recent Updates on Environmental Spills or Releases

E3 and PW received four reports over the January 15-February 15 on hazardous materials and waste management incidents in Commerce City.

- January 25th – Suncor reported exceedances of more than 500 pounds of refinery production gas in a 24-hour period. The incident exceeded the daily limit allowed for releases.
- February 3rd – Complaints about pollution emissions from Suncor by a private citizen related to hydrogen sulfide
- February 10th at 9:58 a.m. - An annual fire inspection identified a general level of negligence at S&S Anodizing, a business located at 9690 Dallas Street.
- February 11th at 12:03 p.m. - Suncor reported hazardous waste mixed with water released from a tank. The waste equaled five barrels and it was released onto the soil and concrete at their location.
