WHEREAS, it is provided by Section 4.21 of the Commerce City Charter that the City Council may, by motion or resolution, change the time and place of any particular regular or special meeting;

WHEREAS, this City Council desires cancelling meetings that fall on or around officially-scheduled city holidays for the calendar year 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2. Holidays.** The City Council meetings that fall on or around the following dates are canceled:

- a. January 19, 2026 – Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- b. February 16, 2026 – Presidents Day
- c. May 25, 2026 – Memorial Day
- d. September 7, 2026 – Labor Day
- e. November 23, 2026 – Thanksgiving
