

ORDINANCE NO. 2746

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, COLORADO WATER CONSERVATION BOARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$47,257.75 TO CONSTRUCT XERISCAPE DEMONSTRATION GARDENS AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources (“DNR”) Colorado Water Conservation Board (“CWCB”) opened the Colorado Water Plan Grant Program to support the implementation of the Colorado Water Plan;

WHEREAS, in June 2025, the City of Commerce City (“City”) applied for funding to construct Xeriscape Demonstration Gardens (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, in September 2025, the CWCB awarded \$47,257.75 to the City to implement the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The 2026 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize the Colorado Water Plan Grant funds totaling \$47,257.75 and to appropriate such funds in the Grant Fund (Fund 180) for a total of \$47,257.75.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
