ORDINANCE NO. 2719

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 21-7601, 21-7612, 21-7622, 21-7655, AND 21-7663 OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE TO PROHIBIT VINYL SIDING IN NEW CONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (the "City") is a home rule municipality and political subdivision of the State of Colorado ("State") organized and existing under a home rule charter pursuant to Article XX of the Constitution of the State;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Charter of the City (the "Charter"), the City has all legislative powers and functions of municipal government as reserved to it by the Constitution and laws of the State; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to update the Land Development Code to prohibit the use of vinyl siding on all new construction in the city; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City reviewed the proposed amendments to the Land Development Code at a public hearing on September 2, 2025 and recommends approval of such amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.
- **SECTION 2. Amendment.** The City of Commerce City Land Development Code, specifically Sections 21-7601, 21-7612, 21-7622, 21-7655, and 21-7663, is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, with a clean version of the sections as amended included as Exhibit B
- **SECTION 3. Repealer.** All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 4. Effective Date**. This ordinance shall be effective pursuant to Section 5.3 of the Charter.
