
Oil and Gas Notice Update

E3 received several Oil and Gas Notices from the Energy and Carbon Management Commission (ECMC) over the last month for three sites: TR RANCH (Commerce City), HSR-LAWSON and HSR-LUNNON (unincorporated Adams County). Each of the sites sent notifications about move-in, rig-up, and the start of plugging and abandonment operations over the month of November.



Adams County Oil and Gas Updates

Adams County sent E3 a memorandum they produced and provided to the Board of County Commissioners (BoCC) about a study on "Cumulative Human Health Risk Assessment of Regional Ozone and Volatile Organic Compounds from Unconventional Oil and Gas Sites in Colorado's Front Range". The study largely mentioned three sites in or adjacent to the City and County of Broomfield and evaluated setback distances.

The results of the study reaffirmed that the County's regulations are more stringent from the State regulations and appear to sufficiently address the health impacts to residents from oil and gas operations.



CDPHE Air Pollution Control Division (APCD) Public Meeting Updates

CDPHE APCD is releasing two new rule concepts and holding upcoming public meetings on both with options to attend the meetings in December and January. The two rules are 1) about potential changes to emission report requirements and permit fees, and 2) potential changes to lawn and garden equipment requirements.

APCD is also holding meetings on potential changes to greenhouse gas emissions and energy management (GEMM) in manufacturing rules for GEMM 1 and 2 facilities in December and January.
