## Sec. 2-3010. Parks, Recreation and Golf Commission

- (a) *Powers*. PRGC shall advise the City Council on matters related to City owned and controlled parks, trails, open spaces, golf and recreation facilities; and parks, recreation and golf programs and services conducted both within and without the boundaries of the City. The Commission will:
  - a. make recommendations pertaining to the planning, development, regulation, maintenance, capital repair and replacement (capital improvement project annual review) and operation of facilities, programs, and services, fees and charges and issues brought forth by the community, boards and commissions and City staff;
  - b. participate in public engagement processes related to the commission's work;
  - c. participate in capital project milestones such as groundbreakings, progress tours, and grand openings;
  - d. participate in the naming of parks, recreation, and golf facilities in accordance with applicable Council Policies;
  - e. promote public awareness and understanding of parks, recreation, and golf programs, services, facilities, and projects; and
  - f. advocate for park, recreation and golf programs and services that support: health and wellness essential to improve individual and community-level health; equitable access for all people; and conservation providing critical green spaces that connect people to the outdoors and are beneficial to our environment.
- (b) Composition and qualifications. The City Council shall appoint up to thirteen (13) commission members as follows: up to nine (9) regular voting members; up to two (2) alternates; and two (2) City Council members.
- (c) *Terms of office*. Except for vacancies in unexpired terms, which shall be filled in accordance with the Charter, the appointment of City Council members whose terms shall coincide with the organization meetings of the City Council, and any appointments made to ensure the appropriate staggering of terms, members shall be appointed for a period of three (3) years and shall serve no more than two (2) consecutive terms or until a successor has been appointed. Members of the PRGAC shall convert to being members of PRGC and shall complete their terms accordingly.
- (d) *Meetings*. PRGC shall meet as necessary to perform its duties. Notice of any meeting of the commission, and the agenda for such meeting, shall be posted on the City's website.
- (e) Quorum. Five (5) regular voting members or alternates shall constitute a quorum.
