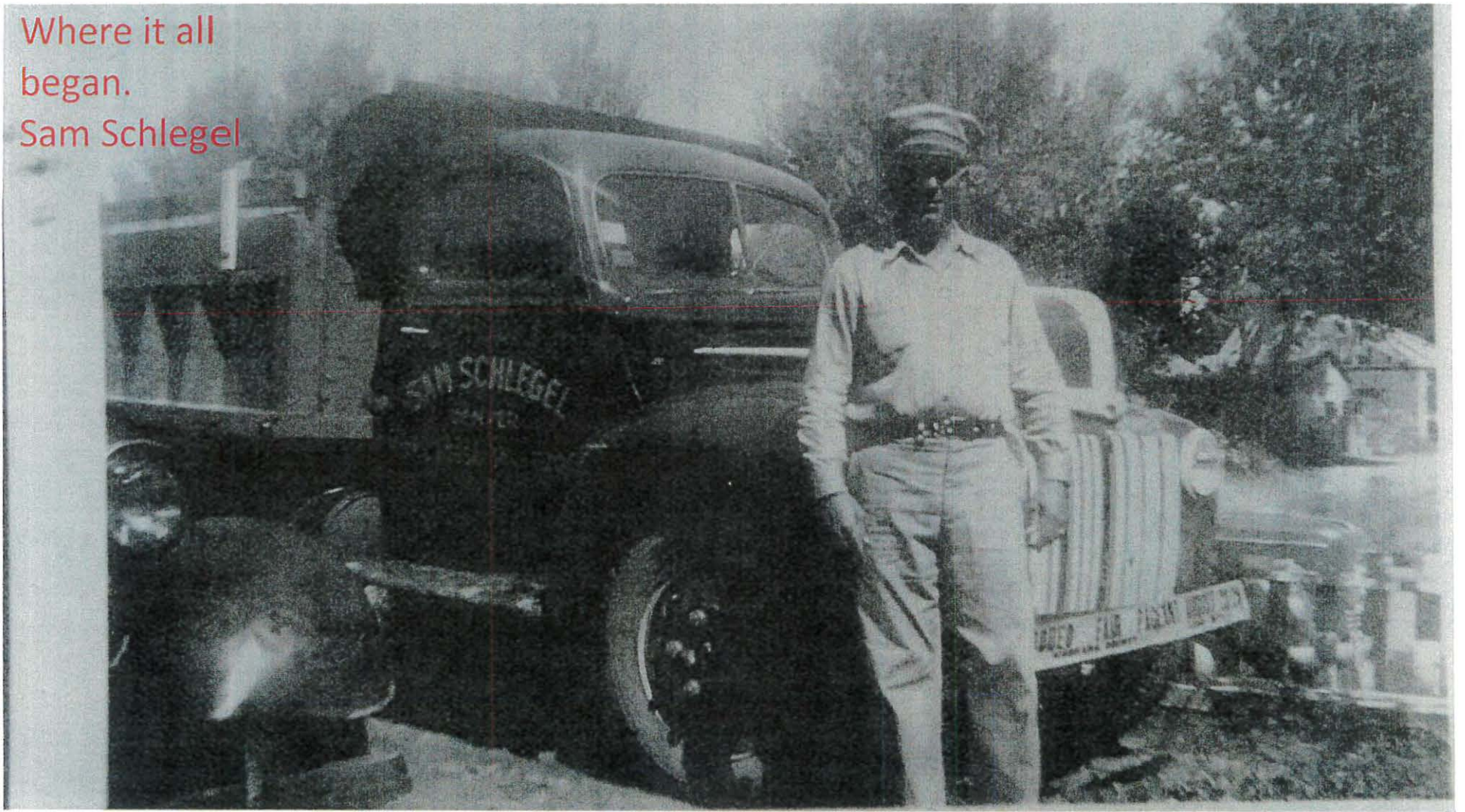

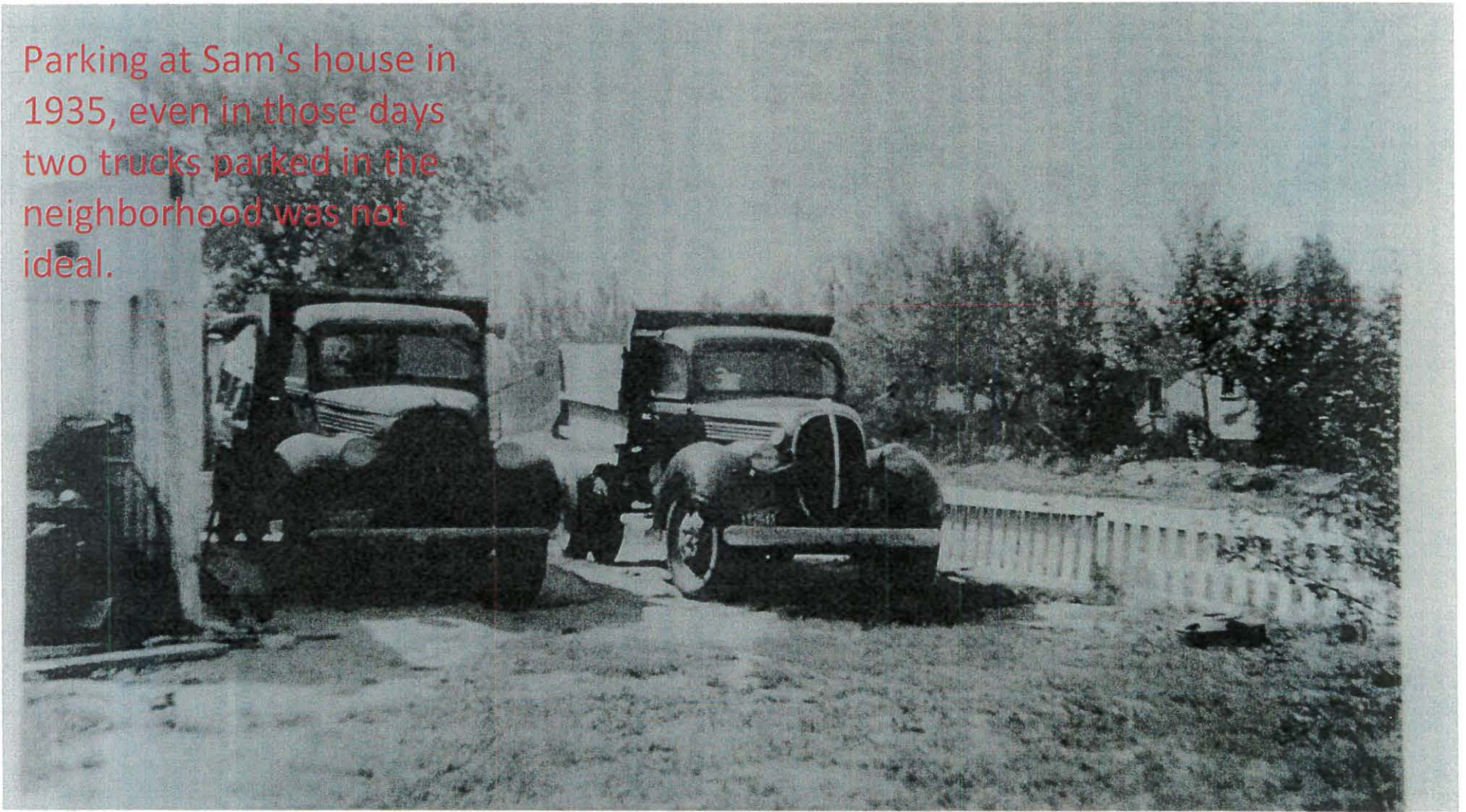

years ago.



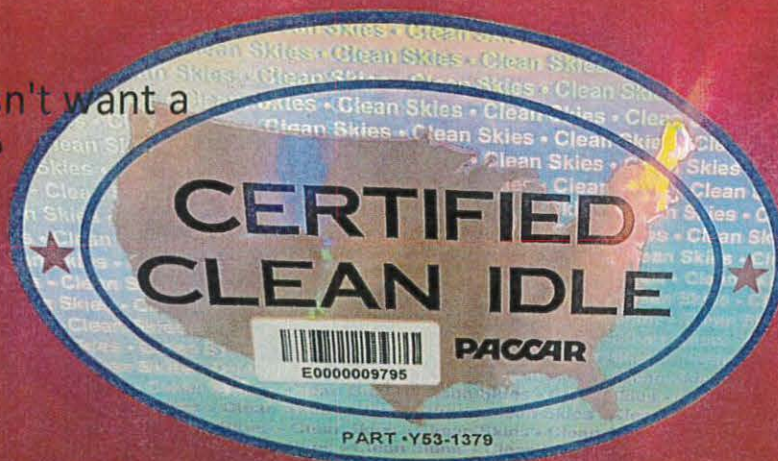
