

ORDINANCE NO. 2619

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO LOCAL ENTITY AIR NETWORK (CLEAN) GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000 FOR LOVE MY AIR PROGRAM ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, the Adams County Health Department (“County”) was awarded a grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for the Love My Air, Colorado Local Entity Air Network (CLEAN) program; and

WHEREAS, this program empowers communities to reduce air pollution and limit exposure through behavior changes, advocacy and community engagement by providing low-cost air sensors, a program data dashboard, and programming to support an increased understanding of the importance of air quality; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) is a sub-recipient and receiving \$1,000 in pass-through funds from the County to design messaging and conduct air quality workshops about the results of sensor data.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization. An amendment is made to the 2024 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Adams County Health Department in the amount of \$1,000 to be used for Love My Air, Colorado Local Program activities (Fund 180).

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
