ORDINANCE NO. 2612

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE SONORAN INSTITUTE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000 FOR THE FUNDING OF A DESIGN FOR A XERISCAPE DEMONSTRATION GARDEN

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") applied for a Growing Water Smart Grant through a partnership between the Sonoran Institute and Lincoln Institute's Babbitt Center for Land and Water Policy;

WHEREAS, the Growing Water Smart Program aims to bring together planners, water providers, elected officials and interested citizens to develop strategies to reduce water demand and address water challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a grant in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), from the Sonoran Institute to fund a Xeriscape Demonstration Garden Design Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.
- **SECTION 2. Budget Amendment.** An amendment is made to the 2024 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Sonoran Institute on in the amount of \$10,000 to be used to fund a project for the design of a xeriscape demonstration garden. (Fund 180)
- **SECTION 3. Repealer.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
