

ORDINANCE NO. 2708

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF GRANT FUNDING FROM DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFIARS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,025 FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Department of Local Affairs (“DOLA”) opened the Law Enforcement Community Services Grant Program to provide grants to law enforcement agencies, local government entities, and community organizations to improve services to communities;

WHEREAS, in March 2025, the City of Commerce City (“City”), on behalf of the Commerce City Police Department, applied for funding to purchase steering wheel locks, gun locks, air tags, hygiene kits, socks, mittens and hats for the Crime Prevention Unit and Co-Response Program to distribute to residents (“Projects”); and

WHEREAS, in August 2025, DOLA awarded \$10,025.00 to the City to implement the Projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The 2025 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize the Law Enforcement Community Services Grant funds totaling \$10,025.00 and to appropriate such funds in the Grant Fund (Fund 180) for a total of \$10,025.00.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
