21-Jul-25	Plant 1 - Tank No. 2	Air	During the annual Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) air inspection on July 21, 2025, it was observed that the Plant 1 – Tank No. 2 was not coated with a paint that has a reflectivity of solar radiation of 0.7 or more. The tank is scheduled to be painted by the end of March 2026. LACK OF COMPLIANT PAINT FOR REFLECTIVITY OF SOLAR RADIATION	NA	NA
21-Jul-25	Plant 1 - Engines D005 and D006	Air	Two small internal combustion engines were identified as having Title V Operating Permit deviations. A permitted diesel generator in the wastewater treatment plant was replaced and documentation was not submitted to Colorado Department of Public Health and the Environment (CDPHE). Documentation for a diesel fired water pump also needs to be submitted to CDPHE. Suncor is developing an engine training program that will improve the communication and tracking of engines	The permittee shall submit an application for a minor permit modification before making the change requested in the application	Engine replaced without an updated APEN. 2nd engine has yet to be added to the permit
