

ORDINANCE NO. 2711

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE COMMERCE CITY REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Commerce City has the power to create boards and commissions under Commerce City Charter Sec. 11.1; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may require boards and commissions to perform such duties as required by the Charter or by Council under Charter Sec. 11.1(b)(1); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide general provisions requiring boards and commissions to perform certain duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Article III of Chapter 2 of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, which the changes are reflected in a clean version set forth in Exhibit B.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective pursuant to Section 5.3 of the Charter.
