REQUEST

Approve a resolution awarding professional services contract to WSB, LLC in the amount of \$395,633.00 for Environmental and Preliminary & Final Design for roadway, drainage, lighting, pedestrian, and bicycle improvements on 68th Avenue between Colorado Boulevard and Brighton Boulevard. The project length is approximately 0.40 miles.

BACKGROUND

This project consists of roadway improvements to 68th Avenue for the purpose of providing bicycle and pedestrian connectivity through sidewalks and bicycle paths to the light rail station near Colorado Boulevard and E. 70th Avenue. The anticipated outcome will improve efficiency and safety for pedestrians and cyclists in the area, including students and families who walk and bike to Alsup Elementary School on the north side of 68th. The improvements would enhance first and last mile connectivity for those walking and bicycling to-from the Commerce City & 72nd Avenue Light Rail Station, which is approximately 0.25-mile to the northeast of the project area.
