## ORDINANCE NO. 2727

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE COMMERCE CITY REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE (CCRMC) REGARDING ADMINISTRATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT BY AMENDING SECTION 2-4102 OF ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 2 TO CREATE A DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY VITALITY

WHEREAS, the City Manager previously created an Economic Development Division of the City Manager's Office to address the on-going economic development of the City of Commerce City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7.1(b) of the City of Commerce City Charter ("Charter"), the City Manager recommends that City Council establish a new Department of Economic and Community Vitality to achieve more efficient operation and administration; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to create a Department of Economic and Community Vitality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.
- **SECTION 2. Amendment.** Section 2-4102 of the CCRMC is hereby amended to establish a Department of Economic and Community Vitality.
- **SECTION 3.** An amended Section 2-4102 of Chapter 2 of the CCRMC is hereby enacted as reflected in Exhibit A herein.
- **SECTION 4. Repealer.** All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 5. Effective Date**. This ordinance shall be effective pursuant to Section 5.3 of the Charter.
