

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION AND FUNDING OF YOUTH RESOURCE AND ASSESSMENT SERVICES BY THE YOUTH RESOURCE AND ASSESSMENT CENTER

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision and Funding of Youth Resource and Assessment Services by the Youth Resource and Assessment Center (“YRAC”) provides youth assessment, referral, and related diversion and support services for various participating jurisdictions in Adams County, including the City of Commerce City;

WHEREAS, YRAC is organized to provide youth resource and assessment services, including coordination with community providers, to promote safety, stability, and lawful outcomes for youth and families;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City desires to join as a party to the Intergovernmental Agreement.

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest of the City’s youth and their families.

SECTION 2. Approval; Execution. The Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, is hereby approved. The City Manager and the City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and attest the Agreement, substantially in the form attached, on behalf of the City. The City Manager is also authorized to execute other documents and agreements or amendments to this Agreement, including annual extensions of this Agreement, consistent with accomplishing the purposes of the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision and Funding of Youth Resource and Assessment Services by the Youth Resource and Assessment Center.
