REQUEST

Approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute a construction contract with Fransen-Pittman Construction Co., Inc. for construction of the Civic Center Remodel.

BACKGROUND

Following the direction of Ordinance 2686 passed by City Council on July 7, 2025, and second reading on August 4, 2025, City staff posted a Request for Proposals for a Construction Manager / General Contractor to perform the construction of the Civic Center remodel project. The City received twenty-two proposals, and a team of Public Works, Police, Finance (Procurement), and City Managers Office selected Fransen Pittman Construction as the most qualified for the project.
