REQUEST

Approve a resolution awarding construction contract to Chavez Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$593,992.15 for the 2025 Asphalt Crack Repair project in the northern areas of the city.

BACKGROUND

Asphalt Crack Repair is a type of maintenance to repair existing cracks and extend the service life of the roadway. The type of crack repair depends upon the condition of the existing cracks. Narrow cracks will be repaired using mastic fill. This is labeled as type A crack repair type on the scope. Large wide crack will be repaired by milling and patching using asphalt. This is labeled as type B crack repair type. The Scope of Work being performed under this contract includes various neighborhoods throughout the northern section of the city with total of 665 cracks to repair.
