## REQUEST

Introduction to the Land Development Code legislative rezoning project, with opportunities for questions and comments.

## BACKGROUND

### LDC Update, Background

The Land Development Code (LDC) is the tool the City uses to regulate the use, form, and intensity of development. The City, with support from consultant Kendig Keast Collaborative (KKC), kicked off the major update to the Land Development Code in spring 2023 to modernize the LDC, streamline review procedures, and create a more user-friendly code. The updates to the Land Development Code were shaped by a robust community engagement process and several study sessions with the Planning Commission and City Council. Following a unanimous recommendation of approval by the Planning Commission, City Council also unanimously adopted the updated Land Development Code on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025.

### Legislative Rezoning Project, Background

Adopting the new Land Development Code was a major milestone, but it only takes effect once properties are rezoned into it through legislative or applicant-proposed rezonings. All new rezonings and annexations must now comply with the 2025 LDC. To complete the transition, Community Development will launch a legislative rezoning effort this year to rezone all properties from the zone districts in the 2009 code to the zone districts in the 2025 LDC, supported by robust engagement with the community, City
