AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,000 FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE (DUI) ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (City) has been awarded a High Visibility Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$18,000 from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to fund driving under the influence (DUI) enforcement efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. An amendment is made to the 2024 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Colorado Department of Transportation in the amount of \$18,000 to be used for driving under the influence enforcement efforts and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized. (Fund 180)

SECTION 2. This ordinance is in the best interests of the City and the public safety.
