

ORDINANCE NO. 2652

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$261,250 FOR A CO-RESPONSE PROGRAM IN THE COMMERCE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Adams County received an allocation of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Coronavirus State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) from the United States Treasury to support recovery efforts including the ability to provide funding to subrecipients to spend on eligible expenditures under ARPA;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) submitted a grant application on June 14, 2024 to the Adams County Health Department (“County”) for ARPA funding to establish a Behavioral Co-Response Program in the Commerce City Police Department; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2024, the City received a grant award of \$261,250 from the County not originally included in the 2025 adopted budget to support the establishment of a Co-Response Program in the Commerce City Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2. Amendment.** An amendment is made to the 2025 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of funds from the American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds via Adams County in the amount of \$261,250 (Fund 180).

**SECTION 3. Repealer.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
