

ORDINANCE NO. 2745

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF COLORADO STATEWIDE INTERNET PORTAL AUTHORITY GOVGRANTS PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$425,000 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Colorado Statewide Internet Portal Authority (“Colorado SIPA”) created the GovGrants Program to provide funding and technical assistance to eligible government entity recipients in Colorado to pursue innovative technology projects;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) applied for \$425,000 to expand body-worn camera technology to include real-time voice translation and automated reporting software for the Commerce City Police Department (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City received a SIPA GovGrant in the amount of \$425,000 to implement the Project, which was not originally included in the 2026 adopted budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

**SECTION 2. Amendment.** An amendment is made to the 2026 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of funds from Colorado SIPA in the amount of \$425,000 (Fund 180).

**SECTION 3. Repealer.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
