ORDINANCE NO. 2614

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$121,660 FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS AT THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES CENTER.

WHEREAS, U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Energy Efficiency Conversation Block Grant (EECBG) program is a formula award in which the City of Commerce City (City) was eligible for a total of \$121,660 as either a grant or a voucher for technical assistance and/or equipment rebate.

WHEREAS, in April 2024, the City applied for an equipment rebate voucher for \$121,660 to install two Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations at the Municipal Services Center (MSC).

WHEREAS, in July 2024, the City was awarded an EECBG equipment rebate voucher in the amount of \$121,660 to fund two electric vehicle charging stations at the Municipal Services Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.
- **SECTION 2. Authorization.** An amendment is made to the 2024 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the U.S. Department of Energy in the amount of \$121,660 to be used for two EV charging stations and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized. (Fund 395)
- **SECTION 3. Repealer.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
