

**A RESOLUTION REGARDING POSTING LOCATIONS FOR ORDINANCES AND
PUBLIC MEETINGS**

WHEREAS, the Colorado Open Meetings Law was enacted by the Colorado State Legislature on April 29, 1991, and this law declares that the formation of public policy is public business and may not be conducted in secret;

WHEREAS, this City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Commerce City to post a listing of public meetings as provided in this resolution;

WHEREAS, the Colorado Open Meetings Law also stipulates that the public place, or places, for posting such notices shall be designated annually; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Open Meetings Law encourages public bodies to post their notices electronically online.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Posting Locations. The locations to give notice of public meetings and ordinances, except for emergency ordinances, shall be as follows:
