BACKGROUND/REQUEST

The majority of City Council and key city staff will be in Washington D.C. for the National League of Cities conference the week of March 16. As such, the City Council will need to motion to cancel the March 16 regular meeting. Additionally, two critical items require City Council action prior to April 1: the ordinance amending code concerning wildfire resiliency, and a resolution creating the Workforce Advisory Committee to establish the purpose, responsibilities, membership, qualification, and term of the committee that was approved by City Council on January 5, 2026.
