

ORDINANCE NO. 2782

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, BY APPROPRIATING UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCE IN THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$463,040 FOR USE ON AN OUTDOOR COMMUNITY ICE RINK AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) has reserves not anticipated or appropriated at the time of the adoption of the 2026 City budget for these new appropriations;

WHEREAS, the City has identified appropriation needs related to a community ice rink for the 2026/2027 season;

WHEREAS, after completing a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) process, Blue Line Sports and Entertainment, LLC, was selected to provide outdoor community ice rink installation, management, maintenance, and removal services for the 2026/2027 season for a total vendor estimated cost of \$403,040 (\$366,400 for vendor services plus an additional \$36,640 for a 10% contingency);

WHEREAS, an additional \$60,000 is needed for marketing, decorations, and other items, for a total outdoor community ice rink cost of \$463,040 for the 2026/2027 season; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to authorize the expenditure of these funds by enacting a supplemental budget appropriation to the 2026 City budget as authorized by Section 12-9(a) of the City Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2. Authorization.** The 2026 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to appropriate funds totaling \$463,040 in the General Fund (010) as detailed below.

- PRG – Outdoor Community Ice Rink (2026/2027 Season)      \$463,040

**SECTION 3. Repealer.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
