

**A RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO PARTICIPATION
BY THE COMMERCE CITY HOUSING AUTHORITY
IN THE COLORADO INTERGOVERNMENTAL RISK SHARING AGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) is a member of the Colorado Intergovernmental Risk Sharing Agency (“CIRSA”), a public entity self-insurance pool providing property/casualty coverage and workers’ compensation coverage, to its members;

WHEREAS, the Commerce City Housing Authority (“Authority”) is a public entity as said term is defined in C.R.S. Section 29-4-203 (other than the state, a county, a city and county, or a school district);

WHEREAS, the City and the Authority entered an intergovernmental agreement for the provision of one or more functions, services, or facilities lawfully authorized to both the City and the Authority;

WHEREAS, the City will be entering into another intergovernmental agreement with the Authority that will require the Authority to procure its own general liability and property insurance coverage;

WHEREAS, the Authority has applied for CIRSA membership; and

WHEREAS, CIRSA requires that the City support the Authority’s application as a prerequisite for membership in CIRSA and the City desires to consent to the Authority’s participation in CIRSA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby supports the Authority’s CIRSA membership.

SECTION 3. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Authority and to CIRSA.
