## BACKGROUND/REQUEST

3K sponsorship request to support transportation for Adams City students to attend Homecoming at CO Mesa.

Inspire is a local nonprofit working with 10 high schools in 5 schools districts across the Denver Metro Area, serving around 1,500 high school Seniors navigate their postsecondary plans. Our work includes partnering with Adams 14 in Commerce City, where we run a Dream Center staffed with two full time Dream Directors who are charged with providing wrap around college & career support to Seniors at Adams City High School.

We are planning a trip to Colorado Mesa University on November 7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>. This visit will be for 30-50 Adams City High School students. Colorado Mesa University will be hosting our students overnight, and students will have the opportunity to attend the Mav Experience on November 8<sup>th</sup>, where they will learn about all of the programs available to them at CMU. The students will also be attending the CMU football game on the 8<sup>th</sup> vs. South Dakota Mines. This will be the 4<sup>th</sup> year CMU will host students from Adams City High School. All meals and lodging will be provided by CMU. Transportation will be provided by D&D Transportation Services, a local Charter Bus Company who is also a recognized vendor by Adams 14 School District. Inspire staff will serve as the chaperones for the students.
