# **REQUEST**

Approve a resolution amending the agreement for services with Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver, INC to include the whole City.

### **BACKGROUND**

The City of Commerce City had previously entered into an agreement with Brothers Redevelopment, INC. under Resolution No. 2024-149, executed on or around December 23, 2024. The original agreement was for general construction services aimed at improving safety, accessibility, and general repairs for certain identified residences within the southern portion of the City, south of 88<sup>th</sup> Ave and west of Quebec Pkwy.

City staff has received consistent request for service outside of the established program area since the implementation of the ACT Home Repair Program. Given the growth in need of service, staff pursues an amendment to the existing agreement to expand the program boundaries to the entire city. There are no other proposed changes to the scope of work to be provided by Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver, INC.

Resolution 2025-111 specifically grants the City Manager the authority to negotiate and finalize these amendments, ensuring the terms continue to meet the City's needs.
