





### Annual CCPD Update – PowerEngage




- PowerEngage is a Community Engagement Platform CCPD Implemented on July 5, 2025.
- It surveys people who telephone police from a cellular phone (on certain call types) to solicit their satisfaction on service.
- We continue to leverage the system with full use anticipated after our Axon RMS is implemented – sometime in Q2 2026.
- Feedback:
  - Survey Response Rate Since Inception 29.1% (sent 9,358 surveys, received 2,723)
  - Citizen Positive Satisfaction Score (CPPS) 77.25%
  - Overall CPPS is trending upward as we respond to system
  - Closing the loop with reporting parties
  - Leveraging the system to have it do more for CCPD and the Community
  - Feedback boards in the PD lobby and briefing room provide feedback to staff
