Request:	Approval of 1 proposed business sign Approval of \$1750.00 in catalyst funds

Discussion:

Detailed case information can be found in the staff report on file at the Commerce City Community Development Department.

City Planner Draper reviewed the staff report and presentation. The applicant is requesting an individual business sign to identify his new business within the Derby District. The applicant is proposing signage that incorporates LED lighting and the 1950's theme found within the Derby Downtown District. The proposed sign faces north, along East 72nd Place. The proposed sign that will face north is approximately 46.77 square-feet.

The applicant is requesting the Derby Review Board approval of \$1750.00 in catalyst funds.

Staff is recommending approval of the proposed sign and catalyst fund request. The proposed signage meets the design principles of the Derby Design Guidelines and the requirements of the Land Development Code.

Applicant was present to answer questions after discussion.

There being no further discussion on the requests, a motion was requested.

Location: Street Landscaping in front of the Derby Resource Center, Commerce City, CO 80022

Request: Approval of landscaping pottery to replace broken pottery within the Derby Downtown District (2 total large rustic ceramic pots)
Approval of up to \$1000.00 in catalyst funds

Discussion:

Detailed case information can be found in the staff report on file at the Commerce City Community Development Department.

City Planner Draper reviewed the staff report and presentation. The applicant is requesting approval of landscaping pottery to replace broken pottery within the Derby Downtown District and catalyst funds up to \$1000.00 to replace 2 total large rustic ceramic pots.

Only one of the three pots has been damaged in the area directly to the East of the Derby Resource Center, 7270 Monaco Street, Commerce City, CO 80022. The damage to pot is the result of a vehicle reversing out of the adjacent angled parking stalls. Although only one of the three existing pots is damaged, the applicant is requesting approval to purchase 2 large new ceramic pots for future replacement or creating a symmetrical pattern.

The applicant (City of Commerce City) is requesting catalyst funds to purchase and install the replacement pottery. Due to the size of the existing pottery, a price range for a replacement has been quoted between \$200 and \$500 per item. If approved, the pottery would be purchased and installed by city staff.

Staff is recommending approval of the request for the new pottery and the corresponding catalyst fund request.

The Derby Review Board agrees that landscaping is an important feature and an inviting characteristic to visitors and users of the Derby District. Maintaining the existing landscaping and looking for new opportunities for landscaping enhancements reinforce the efforts to revitalize Derby. After further discussion, the Board agrees that it would be advantageous to allow for 3 total large rustic ceramic pots to accommodate a complete change out of the pots and have an extra pot in reserve. The Board agrees the amount of catalyst funds would need to be increased from \$1000.00 to \$1500.00.

Discussion on the Vote:

Board Member Anderson moved to amend the request for pottery replacement to a total of 3 instead of 2.
