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### **RECITALS**

A. The State Board of the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund (“GOCO” or the “Board”) is a political subdivision of the State of Colorado, created by Article XXVII of the Colorado Constitution, adopted at the November 1992 General Election, which article appropriates a portion of the net proceeds of the Colorado Lottery to GOCO and directs GOCO to invest those proceeds in the state’s parks, wildlife, open space and recreational resources.

B. The Board and grantee listed above (“Grantee”) entered into a grant agreement dated effective September 17, 2024 at Board’s Contract Number 24884a (“Agreement”). The Agreement establishes the requirements pursuant to the delivery of project outcomes as outlined in Grantee’s Project Application and Interim Planning Documents, as defined in the Agreement.

C. As articulated in the Agreement, GOCO awarded initial grant funding for fiscal year 2024 in the amount of \$82,000.00 and endorsed a strategy to fund an additional \$253,000 for fiscal year 2025. GOCO now desires to add additional funding for fiscal year 2025.

D. On June 21, 2024, the Board used its discretionary authority to approve funding to Grantee listed above (“Grantee”) for the Project for fiscal year 2025, with funding being available to Grantee on or after July 1, 2024.

## ADDENDUM

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties wish to addend the Agreement as follows:

1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by this reference.
2. Time Extension. The parties wish to extend the term of the Agreement until June 30, 2026.
3. Grant Amount. The Board approved funding for Grantees for fiscal year 2024 in the amount of \$82,000.00 through the Agreement. GOCO wishes to increase the grant amount by an additional \$253,000.00 through this Addendum to Grant Agreement (“Addendum”). This funding is awarded in fiscal year 2025 and, therefore, it is effective and available to Grantee on or after July 1, 2024.
4. Matching Funds. Matching funds in the minimum amount required by GOCO as set forth in the approved Budget, or as modified and approved in compliance with GOCO procedures, must have been received by Grantee, or the status of efforts to secure matching funding was disclosed and has been deemed satisfactory by Staff. Grantee (Commerce City) will not be providing matching funds, but other grantees shall provide evidence of matching funds as GOCO may require in its reasonable discretion.
5. Grant Agreement; Addendum. Except as expressly set forth in this Addendum, the Agreement shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect and are hereby affirmed and ratified. In the event of any inconsistency between the terms of the Agreement or any subsequent amendments or addendums and the terms of this Addendum, the terms of this Addendum shall govern and control in all respects. All references to the Agreement shall be deemed references to the Agreement as amended hereby.
