

ORDINANCE NO. 2696

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,000 FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE (DUI) ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) has been awarded a State Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2026 High Visibility Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$8,000 from the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) to fund driving under the influence (“DUI”) enforcement efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City finds and determines that acceptance of the FY 2026 High Visibility Enforcement Grant from CDOT is in the best interest of the public for the welfare of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

**SECTION 2. Authorization.** The 2025 budget of the City is amended to recognize the funds from CDOT , totaling \$8,000 and to appropriate such funds in the Grant Fund (Fund 180) for a total of \$8,000.

**SECTION 3. Repealer.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
