BACKGROUND/REQUEST

Move to direct the City Manager to provide a quarterly report to the City Council focused on advancing community health and well-being.

The purpose of this report is to help the Council better understand and address through policy actions the root causes of health and wellness disparities at the local level, including the role of:

- Access to Quality Housing
- Access to Healthy Foods
- Access to Transportation
- Access to Economic Opportunities
- Access to Quality Healthcare

These updates should highlight how the City can leverage community assets, support policy and systems-level changes, and promote better health and well-being for all residents. The reports should also deepen Council's understanding of the role cities play in driving long-term, systemic improvements to community health.

As part of this effort, I further move to remove oil and gas items from future regular Council meeting agendas and instead align those discussions within the Community Health and Well-Being study sessions, where they can be reviewed in the broader context of resident health, safety, and quality of life.
