Where We've Been


- 2017: Previous website launched



City Council

City Council is the legislative and governing body of Commerce City. The nine members establish the vision for the city, set annual goals to achieve that vision and enact the laws that govern residents. City Council annually reviews



and approves the city budget. They also appoint the <u>city manager</u>, <u>city attorney</u> and municipal court judge, as well as members of <u>boards and commissions</u>.

City Council Meetings

- Regular meetings: 6 p.m. on the first and third Monday of each month except for holidays. Time is dedicated during the regular meetings for public comment.
- Study sessions: 6 p.m. on the second and fourth Monday of each month except for holidays.
- Meeting locations: Unless otherwise designated by the council, meetings take place at the Civic Center at 7887 E 60th Ave., Commerce City.
- Meeting broadcasts: Regular <u>meetings are broadcast online</u> and on local Channel 8.
