2026 DEI Commission Goals

- 1. Goal #1: Support and/or propose legislation to City Council that is informed by community voice.**
 - *Identify any existing data*
 - *Distribute survey to Adams City Gym, King Soopers, schools, library, Food Bank, Connected (include QR code & demographic questions).*
 - *Collect and analyze survey data to inform a city ordinance recommended to City Council next year.*
 - *Conduct community engaged qualitative data (gallery walk, focus groups, etc)*
 - *Begin forming our recommendation to City Council in 2026.*

- 2. Goal #2: Increase attendance and diversity across all events.**
 - *Continue to host Movie Night Events (Black History Month, Women’s History Month, AAPI Month, & Native American Heritage Month).*
 - *Continue to host Juneteenth Flag Raising & Celebration*

- 3. Goal #3: Make regular meetings accessible and educational for community members to attend.**
 - *Guest speaker at meetings on varied DEI topics (Gender diverse education night, event done in Spanish with English translation, ASL/language class, know your rights/civic engagement, defining DEI) - March, May, August, October*
 - *Host DEI meetings at varied locations out in the community, with an emphasis of events in core Commerce City (Greyhound Ground, Reunion Coffee House).*
 - *Attend City Council meetings to understand legislation, and bring awareness to the community. Act as advisory board on DEI agenda items.*
 - *Continue to provide proclamations at City Council meetings.*

- 4. Goal #4: Build new partnerships with community-based organizations.**
 - *Support in administering survey*
 - *Support in gathering a volunteer base or enhancing events.*
 - *Supporting work of partner organizations in return. Identify purpose of attending event to tailor interactions.*
 - *Act as a resource for building inclusive environments for community events & partners.*
 - *CWB, Cultivando, Sikh & Asian communities, Indivisible string, Islesias/churches, Colorado Fiscal Institute, Anythink Library, Adams County Poet Laureate, Rec*
