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REQUEST

Approve a resolution awarding a professional services agreement between the Urban Renewal Authority of the City of Commerce City and CBRE, Inc. up to a maximum amount of \$100,000 for brokerage services, appraisal services, and other advisory services over a two-year term.

BACKGROUND

The CCURA is in need of professional consulting services in relation to the appraisal, acquisition, marketing, and disposition of URA-owned properties. As a reminder, this may include URA properties in areas such as Mile High Greyhound Park, Victory Crossing, and potential future acquisition in Derby.

CBRE was selected as the preferred consultant as city staff conducted an RFP bid, and interviews for these consulting services. Charges to this account will be as needed, as properties are evaluated by the consultant, with a maximum not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000 over two years.
