WHEREAS, the Paradice Island Aquatic Facility ("Facility"), located in the City of Commerce City ("City") is in need of repairs;

WHEREAS, the City desires to make the repairs necessary for Facility to continue to serve the residents of the City and any other visitors;

WHEREAS, the plans contemplated by City are a comprehensive waterline replacement project and a re-plaster of three pools at the Facility (the "Project");

WHEREAS, the City and Adams County wish to enter into an agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, regarding the Grant ("Agreement").
