

ORDINANCE NO. 2666

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF FEDERAL HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2027 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,367,100 FOR ACCESSIBLE PEDESTRIAN SIGNAL AND REGULATORY SIGN UPGRADES IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Highway Safety Improvement Program (“HSIP”) provides funding for the purpose of achieving a significant reduction in fatalities and serious injuries on all public roadways; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) was awarded federal funding from the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (“HSIP”) to be used for accessible pedestrian signal and regulatory sign upgrades.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare and in public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The 2025 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize the HSIP grant funds totaling \$1,367,100 and to appropriate such funds in the Capital Expenditures Fund (Fund 395) for a total of \$1,367,100.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
