

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF GRANT AGREEMENT BY  
AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY AND ADAMS COUNTY  
REGARDING FUNDING FOR RAGWEED DRAW OPEN SPACE AND RIVER  
RUN PARK IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the River Run Park and the Ragweed Draw Open Space (“Facilities”), located in the City of Commerce City (“City”) are in need of repairs and updates and the City desires execute those repairs and updates;

WHEREAS, the City desires to have enjoyable and safe open spaces for City residents to enjoy and where they can engage in outdoor recreation activities;

WHEREAS, the City plans to install a new irrigation systems at the River Run Park ball field and two areas within Ragweed Draw Open Space, as well as install a new playground at River Run Park (“Project”);

WHEREAS, the City applied to Adams County (“County”) for grant funding from the Adams County Open Space Grant (“ACOS”);

WHEREAS, Adams County accepted the City’s application and approved a grant to fund the Project (the “Grant”); and

WHEREAS, the City and Adams County wish to enter into an agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, regarding the Grant (“Agreement”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2. Approval; Execution.** The Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, is hereby approved. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Agreement, substantially in the form attached, on behalf of the City.
