STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Public Works does not recommend rerouting trucks from 96th Avenue as there would then be impacts on other corridors not designed to support the level of traffic or weight of traffic generated from truck routes. Staff does recommend further exploring the truck route on Colorado Boulevard to improve the quality of life for residents along Colorado Boulevard. Staff will pursue contracting a third-party engineering firm to complete the modeling and data collection needed for a complete analysis.
