

ORDINANCE NO. 2759

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF DERBY PLAN AREA FUNDING FROM THE URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,500 FOR THE DERBY PHOTOMETRIC STUDY & LIGHTING PLAN AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, Commerce City and the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) have partnered on the Derby Photometric Study & Lighting Plan (Plan);

WHEREAS, the need for this project was first highlighted in the Derby Business District Urban Renewal Plan (2009) and later reaffirmed in the City's Transportation Master Plan (2010);

WHEREAS, Commerce City received a Crime Prevention Through Safer Streets Program Grant funding amount of \$100,000 from the Colorado Division of Criminal Justice to be used for this Plan;

WHEREAS, the City conducted an Invitation for Bid (IFB) for this Plan, the lowest responsive and responsible bid is \$190,500, and an additional \$90,500 is needed to complete the Plan;

WHEREAS, the URA desires to transfer \$90,500 to the City to contribute to the funding needs of this project; and

WHEREAS, Commerce City desires to receive the \$90,500 transfer of funds from the URA and appropriate said funds to implement the Derby Lighting project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare and in public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The 2026 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize the URA funds totaling \$90,500 and to appropriate such funds in the Grants Fund (Fund 180) for a total of \$90,500.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
