BACKGROUND/REQUEST

Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Adams County Health Department to support the Love My Air (LMA) Colorado Local Entity Air Network (CLEAN) Program sensors located in Commerce City at the Anythink Library and Bison Ridge Recreation Center.

The City of Commerce City grants the Adams County Health Department (ACHD) a revocable non-exclusive license to install, access, maintain, monitor, and repair one air monitor located on property owned by the City at the following locations:

-Bison Ridge Recreation Center 13905 E 112th Ave Commerce City, CO 80022

The City of Commerce City has been part of the LMA Program for three years. The Program encompasses several cities across Colorado. The Program also provides low-cost air sensors, a data dashboard for program information, and support to increase understanding of the impact of particulate matter on air quality and what individuals can do to protect their health.
