Origin of the MDAC

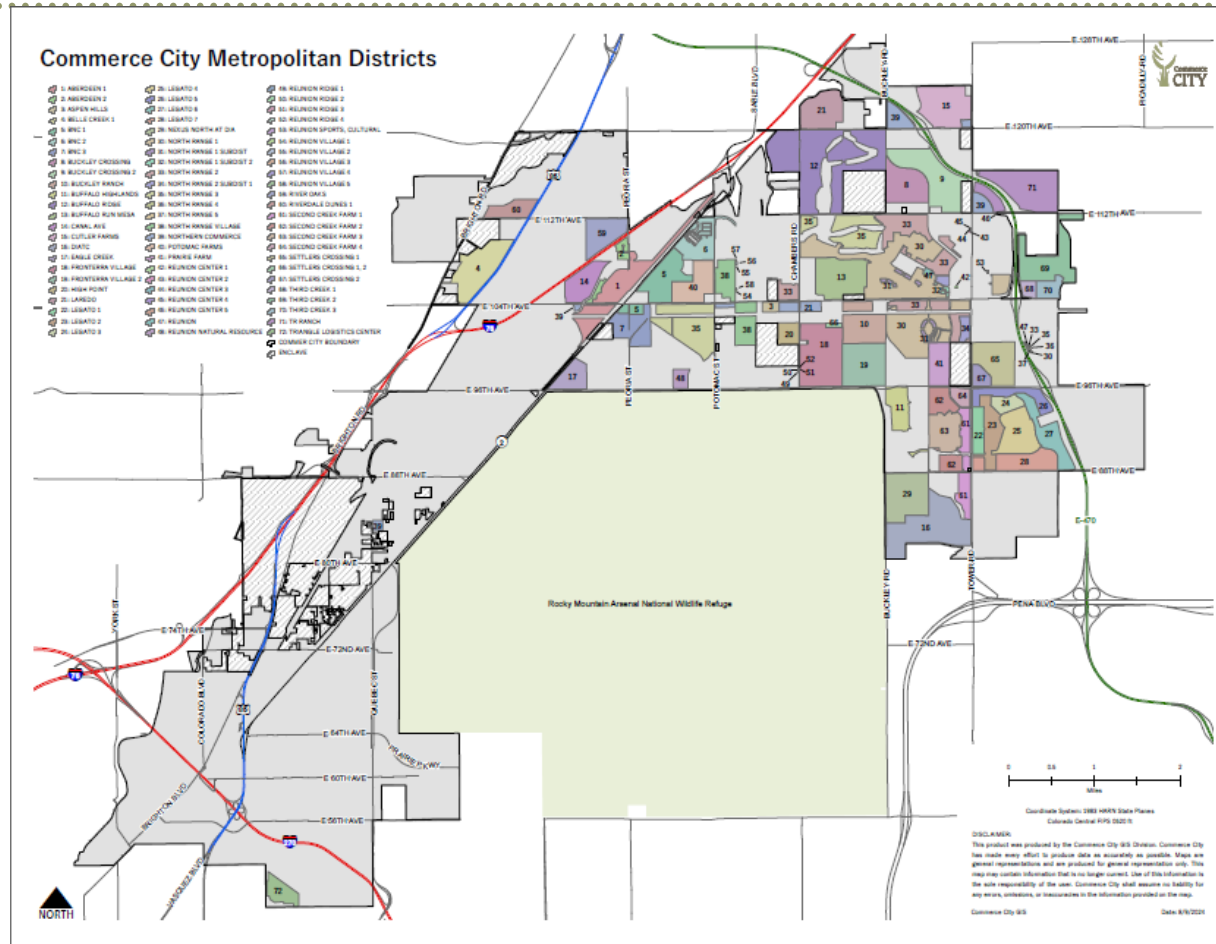
- Per Council motion on July 15th, staff drafted legislation to create an independent commission composed of nine residents, no councilmembers, with equal representation to oversee and review metropolitan district activity and report any findings back to Council. The nine members would be composed of two residents from each ward and one at-large resident.
- The goal of MDAC is to ensure accountability of metropolitan districts in Commerce City.

MDAC Overview

- MDAC shall oversee and review metro district activity and report annually to the City Council any findings.
- MDAC will work with City staff to engage outside professionals to perform audits of all metro districts within City limits.
- MDAC shall meet as necessary to perform its duties.
- Professional service fees shall be funded through the annual oversight fee charged to metro districts.
- There is no time limit on the MDAC (e.g., BREDAC, Comp Plan Advisory Committee)
- The Commission would establish its own bylaws and operating procedures to address the number of meetings and the format of its annual report.
