

Public Art Subcommittee Notes

Celebrations:

- February 22 at 1pm: Cocklebur (corner of 60th & Monaco)

Mural Deaccession:

- Mural from Ratha Sok by Adams City High School originally cost \$66,000 in 2022. Since then we have spent \$17,350 over 13 occurrences to repair the mural from tagging.
- The mural has reached a point where we cannot ensure security of the artwork and the aesthetic integrity of the artwork cannot be maintained or cannot be maintained at a reasonable cost. Because of this, our Public Art Master Plan calls for a review process for deaccessioning/relocating. The committee has reviewed the situation, and have reached a formal recommendation to Cultural Council to pursue deaccessioning for the reasons stated above.
- The artist has agreed to the removal of the artwork. Next steps would be a motion for deaccessioning the mural from Cultural Council, followed by a final approval with City Council.

Sand Creek Project:

- Sand Creek coming to Cultural Council meeting next month to share a project they have planned for 2026. They are planning to do a ground mural in Wetlands Park, which is in Commerce City. Because the park is on city land and is managed by the city, Sand Creek needs Cultural Council approval to move forward. The subcommittee will meet with Sand Creek ahead of the March meeting to learn more.
